What this means for a property

Fort Lauderdale draws from the Biscayne Aquifer and treated the 2025 supply through the Fiveash lime-softening plant and Peele-Dixie nanofiltration membrane plant. The official report states that fluoride addition ended before July 2025 and that chloramines are used for disinfection.
